SBIRT TRAINING

SBIRT is a national best practice screening model that assists the provider community in identifying patients/clients who may have substance abuse issues and/or behavioral health concerns (e.g. depression, anxiety and stress). Screenings are brief, easy to use, and help identify at risk adults who may need additional intervention, referral and treatment. *Some SBIRT services are reimbursable by private insurance and Medicaid.*
